Patty Brosmer made a motion and Dan Fritch seconded the motion to accept the March Meeting Minutes. All were in favor of approval.

OLD BUSINESS:

- 1. Church Renovation Project & Discussion Alan Hoffman
 - a. Exterior Work (Phase II)
 - a. Contracts have been signed for the exterior work and total approximately \$2,149,000.
 - b. Work starting next week with completion targeted for the end of November 2021.
 - c. Stained glass windows will be boarded up
 - d. Trees will be cut down
 - e. Staging area for the construction workers will be on the east end of the south parking lot.
 - b. Interior Work (Phase III)
 - a. Work planned to start in September with a targeted completion in September 2022.
 - b. Construction documents have been approved by the diocese, and we have been approved to move to the bidding process.
 - c. Estimate for the work is \$7,786,000.
 - d. Bidding will start in May.
 - c. Discussed renovation alternates and considerations that could be completed if we have the availability of funds

2. Capital Campaign Update – Dan

- a. Pledges currently total \$7,700,000.
- b. Have over 500 packets outstanding.
- c. Marketing efforts continue to occur.
- 3. **Documentation Plan** *Fr. Andrew*
 - a. Looking at One Drive as an option for a cloud document storage solution.

NEW BUSINESS:

- 1. Usher Program Update Scott and Alison Brandt
 - a. Usher program will be part of the Parish Spiritual Life Commission
 - b. Goal is to develop consistency in ushering between Masses, to improve communication amongst the ushers, and to get more ushers for specific Masses.
- 2. Plan when Mass Dispensation is lifted Van
 - a. Discussed different ways on how to bring people back to Mass when dispensation is lifted. Look to focus on the Eucharist.
- 3. Communications Church Renovation, Parish Events, etc. Van
 - a. Discussed the possibility of a master calendar of parish events in order to provide visibility to parishioners.
 - b. Challenges are determining all of the commission activities/events and then capturing information from all of the stakeholders on a regular basis.
