NEW BUSINESS:

- 1. **Streaming Updates** *Dan Fritch*
 - a. Streaming to YouTube and Facebook is occurring for the Saturday evening Mass at 4:30 pm. Have had some technical difficulties and have been working through them.

 - a. Expecting Dubois County to go to the Yellow advisory level this week which will increase the number of people that can participate in church activities outside of Mass.
- 2. Church Renovation Update Van Ziegler
 - a. Meeting scheduled for the team tomorrow.
 - b. Discussing where to hold Mass when the church is closed for the one-year interior renovation.

- 4. **Net Ministry** Fr. Eugene
 - a. Net Ministry has approved us. Fr. Andrew has met with other area parishes and received their support. Fr. Andrew has secured a van for their transportation during their stay here. The goal would be to start in early September and follow the school calendar. The ministers will stay with host families for two to three week durations.
 - b. The commitment is one year with the potential of a 3 to 5 year program.
