Opening Prayer – Fr John led us in prayer.

Jason Messmer made a motion to approve the May 2022 Parish Council Minutes. Lynn Scheu seconded the motion. All were in favor of approval.

OLD BUSINESS:

1. Church Renovation

- a. Church completion date is scheduled for November 30th. December 10th is the dedication. There will be a contingency plan in the event this is a delay (materials, supply-chain, etc).
- b. A reception will be held after the Church dedication. More details to follow.
- c. Cleaning of the Church will need to occur between completion date and dedication.
- d. A list of items to consider moving has been sent to the appropriate people to coordinate what items will return to Church.

2. Parish Council Nominees

- a. The communication has been published in the bulletin the past several weeks. The next bulletin article will have a deadline when to submit nominations. Reviewed the current candidates who have been nominated or running for reelection and encourage the Parish Council to encourage other Parishioners to participate, as well.
- b. Parish Council election to be held August 13th and 14th. Mail in ballots are due by August 19th. Those on the ballot will be notified the week of August 22nd. The top two people will be invited to attend their first Council meeting on August 30th.

a. Concerns were shared with a Parish Council member about the overall upkeep of the Church grounds. Fr. John will follow up.

7. Donation Walls Review

a. Reviewed the Parish Center Capital Campaign temporary donor wall and shared the image of the Parish Center that would be engraved in wood with the amount. The Our Time Capital Campaign received feedback to list names but not the donation amount.
